Aim: Forming common legal framework within the sphere of sport relations.

Teachers of higher educational establishments, research workers, practicing lawyers, post-graduate students, and external doctorate students, students of Masters' departments (Masters' department, 2nd grade of higher education) and students (Bachelor department, 1st grade of higher education, 3rd – 4th years of studying) are invited to take part in the conference. Participation in the conference can be full-time or virtual.

Scientific and practical articles on the whole range of sport, and legal, economic and management problems in sports can be submitted for publication. Undergraduate students' (1st grade of higher education, 3 - 4 years of studying) articles are accepted in co-authorship with the supervisor. Articles made in co-authorship with other persons will not be accepted.

Guidelines of the conference

1. Sport and law: national and international legislation.
2. Olympic law and Olympic legal relations issues.
3. Adaptive sport (Paralympic, Deaflympic and other kinds): current issues of legal regulation.
4. Professional sport: sport law and order issues.
5. Current issues of labor, civil administrative and criminal relations in the sphere of sport activities.
6. Forms of dispute resolutions in sport.
7. Issues of sport infrastructure development and usage in Russia.
8. Doping control legal regulation in sport..

Requirements for execution of articles and poster presentations

Working languages: Russian, English. Short annotation (up to 350 typographical units with spaces), key words (no more than five). Article length: 5–10 pages. Article text must be presented in file form A 4 size (in MsWord format), Times New Roman 14 print, 1,5 line spacing; new paragraph – 1, 25 sm.; margins: upper, lower, – 20 mm, left – 30 mm, right - 10 mm,; text alignment – breadthwise; without page numbering. References must be put at the end of the article (in articles presented in square brackets) notes. A recommended sample of articles execution is presented in Appendix 1.
